



FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT
IMPACT (FONSI) – BELLEFONTE NUCLEAR PLANT (BLN) REDRESS, JACKSON
COUNTY, ALABAMA

The NEPA Administration staff has reviewed the subject EA and determined that the potential environmental consequences of TVA's action have been addressed, and that the proposed action to cancel construction of the existing facility, to seek the withdrawal of the construction permits, and to redress the BLN site is not a major federal action significantly affecting the quality of the environment. Accordingly, an environmental impact statement is not required.

This FONSI is contingent upon successful implementation of the commitments listed in the Categorical Exclusion Checklist attached to the EA. A copy of the EA and this FONSI will be retained in the NEPA documents room.
