ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI) – FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO CONRON PROPERTIES LLC AND PLASTIC RECYCLING, INC., JEFFERSON CITY, JEFFERSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and TVA's implementing procedures, Environmental Stewardship and Policy has prepared the attached EA and determined that the potential environmental consequences of TVA's action have been addressed. We conclude that the proposed action of participating in bank loans to ConRon Properties, LLC and Plastic Recycling, Inc. in Jefferson City, Jefferson County, Tennessee, to fund about 15% of the cost of the building, improvements, and equipment to expand production of recycled plastic is not a major federal action significantly affecting the environment. Thus, an environmental impact statement is not required.
