



Dear Mr. Tyree:

My wife and I are property owners in the Meadowlake Subdivision, located on Melton Hill Lake and we are strongly opposed to the proposed installation of a raw water intake structure in Bull Run. If the application cannot be denied at this time, a public hearing is requested so that the environmental, residential and recreational impact can be fully evaluated by the community affected by this structure.

As we understand the current proposal Hallsdale-Powell Utility District proposes to shut down an existing operational pumping station located in a non-residential area (in an area that affects no one) and place a newer more powerful structure in a recreational/residential area where the greatest harm would be experienced. No explanation has been given as to why the current pump cannot be modified and/or why a new structure (if one is needed) cannot be located where the existing pump is located. It is clear that it is in the "public" and "environmental interest" to keep the existing structure or a new structure where it is now located.

The placement of this structure in the Bull Run Embayment area would not only effect our subdivision but would affect the surrounding community. The location proposed cannot handle the intake proposal of 8 million gallons a day with the upgradeable capacity of 22 million gallons a day without affecting the fish and wildlife values, land use, navigation, recreation, water supply, water quality and safety of this area. A public park and launch ramp is located within yards of the new proposed structure that benefits the Karns/Claxton community and a railroad track is located where the existing structure is located. I ask you, which building site do you think would effect the public interest the most? We ask that you review and deny the application of Hallsdale-Powell Utility District's request due to the "public" and "environmental" impact on the community.



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The water depth and quality in Bull Run Creek is already significantly lower than the main channel of the Clinch River which is only a couple of miles west of the proposed location. At the proposed water intake location, the creek is only 5-8 feet deep at its most frequent depth. The shoreline of the surrounding area is frequently 4-6 feet below normal pool, and when it is at low pool, the quality of the water decreases dramatically.

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

Dear Mr. Tyree:

I have submitted my support of the neighborhood motion to deny the requested permit under separate cover. This is to document my opposition from a more personal standpoint.

I note that the applicant or your office has not recognized the existence of the Henderson Bend neighborhood on your site map. This is a relatively new (established in 1997) neighborhood approximately one mile west of the site proposed for the water intake. We will be adversely impacted by the Intake through most of the issues given in the above submittal.

Further , we currently accept both the TVA Bull Run Steam Plant and its associated ash disposal operations as well as a very active CSX rail line as parts of our neighborhood. Additional industrial or utility operations are certain to reduce property values and to restrict development in an area of Anderson County that is otherwise attractive because of its location. It is clear to me that the neighborhood has done enough to accommodate public service needs.

Please also note that the site of the proposed water intake is quite shallow and that the embayment as a whole is commonly subject to large changes in water level throughout the year. There is an abundance of water in the main channel only a mile or so away and locating there would have none of the impacts we have expressed concern about.

This is to request that the permit be denied. At the very least , I request that a representative of your office make a site visit to review the concerns expressed here and in the neighborhood submittal and that a public hearing be held before granting approval.

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

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

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

We have just learned of the proposal to install a Raw Water Intake Structure in Bull Run
Creek. We are very concerned about the proposal and object to the proposed location in Bull
Run Creek. We have signed the enclosed letter showing our agreement with our neighbors
that this structure will have a negative impact on the enjoyment of this portion of the lake.

In addition to the concerns listed on the attached letter, we wanted to express that we strongly
oppose the proposed intake since it will dramatically change the temperature of the water.
Water temperatures in the Clinch River can be 10 degrees (or more) colder in the summer
months than the water temperatures in Bull Run Creek. Three years ago we based our
decision on where to raise our family of four children on the basis that we could live on the



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
