There has been much concern over this project from the Friends of Pickwick Group comprised of private citizens. We receive frequent complaints and just comment of overall disapproval of how the shoreline area and very natural cove areas are being so easily developed.

This office would like to comment to the effect that The Preserve project does have the appearance of being piece-mealed (boat ramp, floating docks). This office of the Division of Water Pollution Control would like to suggest or ask that the TVA (Muscle Shoals office) and/or the Nashville District Corps office work with The Preserve and/or other developments (i.e. North Shore) on this project and in the future to create an overall management plan for the entire shoreline area to streamline shoreline development issues as a whole and avoid a piece-meal approach and possible cumulative impacts in this part of the Pickwick Reservoir.

Please consider these comments when processing the public notice identified above and all others that may occur in the Pickwick Reservoir.

Dear Colonel Roemhildt:

Fish and Wildlife Service personnel have reviewed the subject public notice. The proposed project would involve the construction of five floating community boat docks for residential use in the Haw Branch Embayment at Tennessee River Mile 209.6R, Hardin County, Tennessee. The five docks would extend between 36 to 48 feet lakeward from the normal summer pool elevation, and accommodate a total of 53 boats. The public notice indicates that no dredging is proposed. The applicant (The Preserve Marina Owners Association) also proposes to construct a 24-foot-wide boat launching ramp that meets the criteria for Nationwide Permits #36. The following constitute the comments of the U.S. Department of the Interior, provided in accordance with provisions of the Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act (48 Stat. 401, as amended; 16 U.S.C. 661 et seq.) and the Endangered Species Act (87 Stat. 884, as amended; 16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.).

Endangered species collection records available to the Service do not indicate that federally listed or proposed endangered or threatened species occur within the impact area of the project. We note, however, that collection records available to the Service may not be all-inclusive. Our data base is a compilation of collection records made available by various individuals and resource agencies. This information is seldom based on comprehensive surveys of all potential habitat and thus does not necessarily provide conclusive evidence that protected species are present or absent at a specific locality. However, based on the best information available at this time, we believe that the requirements of section 7 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended, are fulfilled. Obligations under section 7 of the Act must be reconsidered if (1) new information reveals impacts of the action that may affect listed species or critical habitat in a manner not previously considered, (2) the action is subsequently modified to include activities which were not considered during this consultation, or (3) new species are listed or critical habitat designated that might be affected by the action.

We do not anticipate significant adverse impacts to fish and wildlife or their habitats as a result of this project. Therefore, the Service has no objection to the issuance of a permit for the work described in the subject public notice.

To whom it may concern:

I would like to take this opportunity to express my personal support of the Preserve at Pickwick, as well as, placing a few things in perspective that you may wish to consider.

I moved to Pickwick nine years ago and although I'm not a lifetime resident of the area, I am quite cognizant of the happenings in and around Pickwick Lake. I presently serve on several boards and organizations in the community serving as treasurer of the Friends of Pickwick Landing State Park, treasurer of Hardin County Chamber of Commerce, board member of the Southwest Tennessee Tourism Association, secretary of Pickwick Landing Rotary Club, finance chairman of Shiloh Falls, finance chairman of Pickwick United Methodist Church and member of several other civic organizations.

I personally feel I can offer a glimpse of the real Pickwick contrary to the version I've heard presented by just a very few dissatisfied and unsupportive residents in the area. Although I'm not speaking officially for the groups I'm involved with, I would like to express my views and the sentiments I know exist with the over-whelming majority of residents in the Pickwick area.

First, I would like to dispel some confusion that might exist between a group registered as the Friends Of Pickwick Inc. which opposes progress at Pickwick not to be confused with a group called Friends of Pickwick Landing State Park (a 501c3 group) consisting of 100 plus members. At last weeks Board meeting, our board members verbally supported the Preserve at Pickwick and the economic benefits that could result from the planned development and voiced their concerns of our Friends group being confused with the other group. The Friends of the Pickwick Landing State Park sees the Preserve at Pickwick having the same goals and visions as our group in that both groups want to support recreational activities while being cognizant and supportive of the environment. The Preserve at Pickwick meets this test.

Second, I would like to express my views and the views of my fellow Rotarians by offering our support of the Preserve as we feel the economic benefits generated from the Preserve at Pickwick including the marina certainly outweighs any negative response I have heard. The Preserve at Pickwick is an exceptionally well-planned development that offers recreational activities while maintaining an excellent balance with the environment.

Third, At last week's chamber of commerce meeting our board unanimously voted to offer our support of the Preserve at Pickwick even though the development was not on our membership roles. Our chamber could not imagine any group being opposed to the Preserve as all indications are that the development offers a well-planned community keeping nature and the environment to the forefront while offering superb recreational activities for its residents. The entire county should benefit from the economic impact this development will have on our area and the opportunity our area can reach out to retirees who can relocate here.

Fourth, I presently live in a competing gated community to the Preserve but I can already notice additional interest in our development because of the exposure of the Preserve. The Preserve's uniqueness to Pickwick Lake offers tremendous benefits to our entire area thus a win-win situation for both developments. Like Shiloh Falls, I see the Preserve equally responsible to their residents and to the environment in the construction of their marina as I see our marina has done.

Although I can't specifically offer any concrete and precise evidence of the support for the Preserve at Pickwick, I would suspect that the Pickwick area over-whelming supports the Preserve at Pickwick and that support could exceed 98% of the residents.

I would like to 'thank you' in advance for taking the opportunity to consider my remarks about the positive support I feel the Preserve at Pickwick has in our community.

The applicant proposes to construct five private, covered, floating community boat docks in the Haw Branch Embayment of Pickwick Lake in Hardin County.

The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency has concerns regarding this project. The area of Pickwick Lake where this project is proposed has numerous boat docks and is a high traffic area for recreational boating and commercial vessels. The Haw Branch embayment is one of the last coves in this area of Pickwick Lake where jet skiers can safely recreate. The upstream section of Haw Branch is used extensively by sport fishers seeking largemouth and smallmouth bass, species very valuable to recreational sport fishers. We are concerned about the potential boating safety issues, reduction in area of public waters available to recreational boaters (such as jet skiers), and reduction in area of public waters available to sport fishers within Haw Branch. The placement of the boat docks in Haw Branch will probably deter sport fishers from fishing this area and inhibit their navigation upstream past the docks due to increased boating traffic and associated safety issues. The applicant should also be aware that if the boat docks are permitted, it is highly unlikely that they would qualify for a no wake zone.

Although it is stated in the figures provided in the public notice that all of the proposed boat docks will be under the third of the cove rule, we are uncertain that this is the case after reviewing the information in the public notice. It appears that docks A, B, and C may conform to the rule, but docks D and E may not. If you include the distance from the shoreline for dock D and E (12 feet) and add it to the 24 feet for the header and dock fingers, then the constructed dock will extend 36 feet into the embayment (36 feet times 3 = 108 feet); where the channel width is only 105 feet at these locations, which will exceed the third of the cove rule by 5 feet.

The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency requests that this permit be held in abeyance until our concerns regarding boating safety issues and recreational use issues are addressed by the

applicant, and it is determined that the proposed project does not violate the third of the cove rule. If the applicant fails to agree to the above condition, we request that the permit be denied.




Please seriously consider the following facts and comments respectfully submitted by our conservation group, "Friends of Pickwick, Inc.", on 'Joint Public Notice 07-01, Application 2006-040797 by "Preserve Marina Owners Assoc. Inc." issued 1.12.07 for public comments by U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and Tennessee Valley Authority, for "Proposed Community Docks" and "pre-approved boat ramp" at mile 209.6, Pickwick Lake, Tenn. FYI: The original public comment period on this controversial project has been hampered by a series of serious issues and delays involving difficulties getting requested meetings and information (including over 400 pages of related FOIA requested information that arrived the day before last public comment deadline). Altho TVA/COE initially refused another extension, (even though we only had 24 hours to review 416 pages of info), officials did grant us last minute extension again, giving us thru 3.13.07 for our final comments. Unfortunately, 619 pages of potentially critical data was excluded by TVA from these recent FOIA requests, much of it info originally publically presented by TVA officials in 2000 (and requested thru proper channels for over 8 months), but we'll address and appeal that significant information gap separately. This e-mail to be followed by FDX hard copies of comments, plus photos, graphics, references. Please also consider all previous e-mails, graphics, letters, faxes, postcards and issues raised during our discussions, as part of official record of 'Friends of Pickwick' comments and concerns.

The following summarizes majority of our regulatory and policy compliance issues...our concerns relating to the EA review process itself...and most important, the direct, indirect and cumulative adverse environmental impact this entire project will have on vanishing natural resources at Pickwick Lake, if this permit is approved.

1. **Critical, pertinent, environmental info, on this project and area, withheld for months by TVA officials:** Only 1 page (of 416 pages of FOIA info rec'd 2.6.07) related to assets of cove. All environmental data TVA presented in 2000 excluded. But, in 1/2000 land swap ap, (that involved this same cove), developer states 'Public Benefits' as: "The project would be something both developer and TVA agreed on. Haw Branch would become a forever protected and undeveloped cove. This would enhance boaters', fishermen's and recreational use of the lake because of the privacy and natural habitat of existing terrain and wetlands area." In spite of some wording issues, his statement confirms what TVA officials advanced at the time...that back of this cove was pristine, critical habitat, adjacent to protected wetlands, but cove too narrow, so many environmental restrictions, it was "virtually undevelopable" - so that's why developer wanted to swap it for more lucrative waterfront in front of 2 coves (one was Haw Branch). But now, TVA officials openly support permit approvals for cove development - boat docks, 200' ramp, 160' jetski pier, 53+ boat slips (for starters?). Flip-flop? Why? TVA also still withholding info verifying valid environmental restrictions.
2. **More issues with transparency of process, equal access to information, as background to controversy:** In 5/'06, developer publishes plans showing "Full Service Marina" in same cove TVA had said was "virtually undevelopable" in 2000 ("due to environmental restrictions"). Our authorized calls seeking 26a permit activity information (from May thru Nov '06) thru proper TVA channels, produces nothing. Then, a Christmas surprise. TVA gets piecemeal "pre-approval" of 26a permit (via invalid 'Exclusion') for big boat launching ramp, integral part of marina project.
3. **Violation of NEPA 'Categorical Exclusion' regs barring "controversial" projects from automatic (CE) exclusion.** Besides piecemeal issues, regs state any action normally qualifying as (CE) exclusion shall NOT be so classified if there is substantial (or likely to become) controversial. We can document controversy, official awareness, scope, etc !

4. **'After the fact' Violation: Reviewers notes on CE Checklist dated 4-5 weeks AFTER ramp permit approved.**
Altho "pre-approved" boat ramp permit, (via a questionable Categorical Exclusion) was approved by TVA on 12.20.06 (2 days after \$200 fee was paid), 40 out of 52 of reviewers notes on the Categorical Exclusion (CEC) were dated 1.25.07, over 4 weeks AFTER permit was approved. Why? Isn't this highly inappropriate, "after the fact" reviewing? Is this valid? Also noted - many highly questionable "No" checkmarks totally misrepresent impact.
5. **Violation of '26a Permit' regs preventing adverse impact on public land (marina ramp adjoins TVA public land)**
Since 200' boat ramp will have severe impact on public land, this project was ineligible for automatic 26a permit.
6. **Violations of several sections of '26a Permit' regs due to boat ramp NOT built according to approved plans.**
Boat ramp not built in location shown on approved permit plans. Permit should be revoked, as we've requested.
7. **Issues with feasibility, spec sizes, compliance issues and no dredging claims on boat docks, pier and boat ramp.**
We challenge specs showing that all the docks, with sizes shown...(with the space from shoreline to edge of dock being confirmed as 10-12 feet). Will plans comply with one-third-of-cove rule at summer pool? We also take serious issue with contention that no dredging will be required due to the apparent gentle sloping of shoreline visible at winter pool (see photos to follow taken 2.22.07) and required draft for boats. Plus, we have concerns about dredging regarding boat ramp. Was it done during pre-construction as markings on edge of bank seem to indicate? What about area under the boat ramp, to provide access and required depth for trailers, was that area or will that area be dredged? No shoreline erosion measures around boat ramp visible 2.22.07. We have serious issues with claims that docks can be built and 50+ boats moored in this narrow, shallow back of cove without dredging.
8. **Piecemeal issues with "pre-approval" of boat ramp permit vs. total project and other review/permit issues:**
In first phone call with Lisa Morris, COE on 1.16.07, when I explained issue with boat ramp being referred to as "pre-approved" in 1.12.07 Public Notice...even tho it was a boat ramp for the same project...at the same exact site...for same applicant, "Preserve Marina Owners Assn Inc.", Ms. Morris quickly responded that this would be **unacceptable** to the Corps since that's "**piece-mealing**". We were concerned with the practice and obvious implications but unaware of term or legalese, however we did some research, submitted questions on this issue several times, but don't recall getting meaningful official response at all from any official. However, now we have it on good authority that regulations are clear (including NEPA) that what has happened here does NOT comply with regulations prohibiting piecemeal approvals like this...due to the fact that the long-term, overall, CUMULATIVE Impact can never be accurately assessed if portions of projects are routinely approved in this piecemeal way. And, even when we saw that the wrongfully pre-approved boat ramp had already been built (seen during site visit 2.22), contrary to our many previous challenges, officials just they they were unaware it was already underway...besides "they already had the permit". Even when shown later, boat ramp was not built according to approved plans in the permit application...but at different location, no reaction from officials. (Were we expecting a **lack of impartiality** in the process at every stage of reviews?) We also challenged the fact that COE, NWP permit limits the boat ramp to 20 ft wide, yet specs on one permit ap showed width as 24 ft. How wide is it? It appears to us that this may be a case of fast-track approval (in a few days over Christmas), get it built ASAP during low water, and deal with any problems later (just ask "**forgiveness**" later)? Also, since then, we reported boat ramp was not built as shown on permit plans (different location) and possibly encroaches on TVA public land. TVA official, Stan Davis, agreed the topo map made it unclear if new location for boat ramp was just adjoining or actually encroaching on TVA land .
9. **Is this project in compliance with SMI shoreline regulations and all TVA/COE formal environmental policies?**
Even tho 'policies are not law' and documented decisions in federal register (1999 SMI/2002 FEIS) regs are not either...but isn't the health of our environment and the integrity of our system better served when officials enforce regs and honor policies that dedicated agency experts have spent years developing, and taxpayers and stakeholders have spent millions funding? Like the \$5.2 million on SMI? FYI: Most of Pickwick was actually grandfathered out of important SMI (shoreline management) regs during 6 of the most frenzied, rampant development periods ever! Since "The Preserve" was only recent project NOT grandfathered, are all SMI regs being enforced? In lieu of project scope, permit numbers, wouldn't a multi-agency, 'big-picture' approach better serve protections and public interest?
10. **Consider an alternate location, protect public lands and "preserve" pristine cove as a signature feature of "The Preserve!"**

It should also be noted that altho it took us over five weeks to get TVA and Corps officials to agree to an on-site meeting to verify specs, consider site specific issues, etc., the meeting also gave us an opportunity to discuss the steps in NEPA Environmental Assessment review and decision making process and what we could expect, time-wise, following submission of our comments after the deadline. While reviewing details of the NEPA/EA process with Stan Davis, Sr. TVA/NEPA Specialist and Amy Robinson, COE, we heard that after all public comments were reviewed, the applicant was also given an opportunity to review all public comments and then submit additional comments. We asked how long does applicant have review and rebut all public comments? Ms. Robinson, replied, "as long as they like." When we requested the same access to public information and comment opportunity as the developers, we were told by officials they did not see a problem with that, so we trust when the appropriate time comes, we'll be given the same equal access and opportunity to comment as given to the applicant/developers.


While we recognize the complexity of this cross-jurisdictional permit review process, we urge all TVA and Corps officials to seriously consider all the regulatory, policy and public interest issues raised here and previously, by our conservation group and informed government agencies, such as, Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency. We appreciate this respected agency's expertise and their request this permit "be held in abeyance" until all concerns regarding accuracy of permit specs (boat dock sizes vs. one-third-of-cove rule), as well as "boating safety, recreational uses". And, if all these issued not resolved, TWRA requests permit be denied. We wholeheartedly concur, plus...

We also respectfully request again, that a public hearing be held so the public can be fully informed on the details, scope, and potential impact of this project...and that this permit review process be elevated beyond a more "routine" 'EA', to full EIS in lieu of facts that: (a) Haw Branch was once described by TVA as "narrow pristine (critical) habitat, with adjacent protected wetlands" that "abounds with springs, streams, forests and wildflowers," * and (b) adverse impact on adjoining public lands, water quality, habitat, etc. will be severe...(c) cove is a virtual safe harbor, last refuge in area for recreational boaters and fishing"...(d) Haw Branch is "scarce natural resource area" with protection due to status as "unique in nature...and scarce in quantity, in area or region"...and finally, (e) this pristine narrow cove adjoins newly TDEC designated "Exceptional Tier II Waters", yet (TDEC, TVA, COE) admit to limited resources to do full environmental assessments of this natural treasure. A full EIS could get that done.

We object again to the pre-emptive, 'pre-approval' of the 200 ft boat ramp, an integral part of this same project, on same site, by same applicant. This piecemealing violates regulations requiring all related permit applications be submitted and reviewed at same time. 33 CFR 325.1(d)(2), 40 CFR 1502.4 & 1508.24 (CEQ Regs).

Furthermore, to allow this "Preserve Marina Owners" project to be considered separately from the massive 1200 acre "Preserve at Pickwick" *parent project*, (with a multitude of past, present, future permits, involving nearby shorelines, upland areas, adjoining public land, wetlands, nearby state park, same watershed, and more), seems tantamount to piecemeal reviewing vs. considering the 'big-picture' impact, (as 'Friends of Pickwick' suggested to both TDEC and TVA officials many months ago). As we now know, this 'non-segmented' approach is addressed in regulations mandating "proposals, or related parts of proposals, reasonably related to same project", should be included (or evaluated) in the same application. NEPA regs define connected and cumulative actions that must be considered in same document (EA or EIS). Piecemealing violates both the letter and spirit of regulatory requirements.

On behalf of residential and recreational "Friends of Pickwick" and for reasons stated, we formally request officials enforce established regulations, honor formal policies and deny this permit to "Preserve Marina Owners Assn Inc." Please preserve Haw Branch. Prevent the inevitable, significant adverse, direct, indirect and cumulative impact that this highly questionable project would have on these vanishing natural resources and the public trust.

FYI..3/6/07...FROM FOIA INFORMATION FINALLY REC'D By Friends of Pickwick, after MONTHS of requests thru channels (for environmental info presented by TVA during proposed Pickwick land swap in 2000) then FOIA starting 1.18.07. This is page 5 of 416 total pages...from application by developer for land swap...saying "HAW BRANCH would become FOREVER PROTECTED and undeveloped cove...enhance boaters', fishermen's, recreational use because of privacy and the NATURAL HABITAT of existing terrain and WETLANDS area." Altho, front of this cove was to be developed if land swap had not failed (due to land appraisal discrepancies we exposed - \$474K vs. over \$3 Million!)...THIS CONFIRMS WHAT WE'VE SAID ALL ALONG...that TVA officials said in 2000 that back of cove COULD NOT/WOULD NOT be eligible for any development permits due to environmental restrictions on natural habitat, shorelines, adjacent wetlands...which was the very reason developer wanted to swap it off for "high value shorelines" in front of Haw Branch and only only other undeveloped public lands in area, Lower Anderson cove. SO WHY THE TOTAL ABOUT-FACE NOW BY TVA by fast-tracking/facilitating new permit approvals, denying any potential "adverse impact" of new proposed development?

ALSO...Even tho we have requested this and IG information repeatedly for MONTHS, it arrives the day before the FINAL DEADLINE FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS on permits submitted by PRESERVE MARINA OWNERS ASSN INC for this same cove. There is no way we can review all 416 pages in 24 hours, evaluate and submit comments based on this very important and pertinent information. WE FORMALLY REQUEST A 30-60 DAY EXTENSION SO WE CAN REVIEW INFORMATION FINALLY RECEIVED AND SO TVA/COE CAN REVIEW/ADDRESS OTHER UNRESOLVED ISSUES AND RESPOND TO OTHER VALID QUESTIONS WE'VE SUBMITTED (Environmental parameters, models & NEPA).

5.0 Procedures

5.1 Action Formulation and NEPA Determination

Each office within TVA is responsible for integrating environmental considerations into its planning and decision making process at the earliest possible time to ensure that potential environmental effects are appropriately considered to avoid potential delays and to minimize potential conflicts. Environmental analyses are to be included in or circulated with and reviewed at the same time as other planning documents. This responsibility is to be carried out in accordance with the environmental review procedures contained herein.

The General Manager and Board of Directors are the major decision points within the agency for TVA's principal programs that are likely to have a significant effect on the quality of the human environment. Alternatives considered by the General Manager and Board of Directors shall be encompassed by the range of alternatives discussed in relevant environmental documents, and the General Manager and Board of Directors shall consider the alternatives described in relevant EISs.

At the earliest possible time, the office proposing to initiate an action will initially determine the level of environmental review required for a specific action. The level of review will be in one of the following categories:

Categorical Exclusions	5.2
Environmental Assessments	5.3
Environmental Impact Statements	5.4

5.2 Categorical Exclusions

Categories of actions listed in this section are those which do not normally have, either individually or cumulatively, a significant impact on the quality of the human environment and require neither the preparation of an EA nor an EIS. The office proposing to initiate an action shall determine, in consultation with the Environmental Quality Staff as appropriate, whether or not the proposed action is categorically excluded. An action which would normally qualify as a categorical exclusion shall not be so classified if: (1) the proposed action could have a potentially significant impact on a threatened or endangered species, wetland or floodplain, cultural or historical resource, important farmland, or other environmentally significant resource; or (2) substantial controversy over the significance of the environmental impacts associated with the proposed action has developed or is likely to develop. Categorical exclusion actions are:

1. Routine operation, maintenance, and minor upgrading of existing TVA facilities.
2. Technical and planning assistance to State and local organizations.
3. Personnel action.
4. Procurement activities.
5. Accounting, auditing, financial reports, and disbursement of funds.
6. Contracts or agreements for the sale, purchase, or interchange of electricity.

south side of the lake several years ago. Proponents argue that putting the undeveloped acres to use as a public hiking and fishing area would represent the highest and best use of the land. But more than 200 people have signed petitions opposing the exchange because they believe it would cause environmental damage and cheat TVA ratepayers.

The economic aspect of the deal is its most questionable element. Lakefront lots on the north shore of Pickwick are listed at prices between \$175,000 and \$250,000. The shore is quickly becoming crowded with vacation and retirement homes that sell for a half-million dollars or more. The property TVA would get in return for its 23 acres can be developed, but it is farther from the main body of the lake and worth less on the market. A TVA spokesman says the trade conforms to the federal utility's "maintain-or-gain" policy, which is designed to protect environmental and recreational benefits available to the public along the shorelines of TVA reservoirs.

A 50-foot-wide buffer along the shoreline, below the land given to the developer would help protect the lake's water quality. But it would have negligible effect on the value of the property. A hiking and fishing area for general public access surely would be a valuable addition to the recreational opportunities of the Pickwick Lake area. Some of the property has been clear-cut for commercial purposes, but it abounds with springs, streams, forests and wildflowers.

The question is whether that new recreational area could be obtained at a lesser price. According to a TVA spokesman, a TVA appraisal indicates the land it would give up and the property it would receive in the swap are of comparable value. That is a questionable assertion, however. Critics have additional concerns about the esthetic effects of the deal, which would allow development on land near the mouths of two coves that now offer an uncluttered view of the Pickwick shoreline.

The sheer rate of development on the shores of the lake is an-

other reason for opposition to the land swap. To others, the proposed exchange simply has the appearance of favoritism toward a major local developer.

Eddie Clarel, chief manager for Montana Land, points to the favorable amount of acreage the public would get in the deal, the benefits to the Hardin County tax base and the inevitable development of other lakeside property on land the company owns. That assessment may be valid, but the way TVA is making this deal is the problem.

An environmental review of the project is nearing completion and public comments on the deal are being reviewed. TVA's three-member board is expected to make a final decision later this year.

THE BOARD should send this deal back for reconsideration. It leaves too many questions unanswered about some of the public's most attractive real estate.

TVA promotes iffy proposition at Pickwick

THE PUBLIC might benefit from the trade of 23 acres of lakefront property at Pickwick for 164 hilly, wooded acres nearby. But that proposition remains to be demonstrated.

The Tennessee Valley Authority, the publicly owned utility that owns the 23 acres, has never put the property on the market. The swap with the Savannah, Tenn.-based Montana Land Co. was arranged privately, with inadequate exploration of available options.

The arrangement proposed by the company would put 164 acres of land along the upper end of Haw Branch under TVA control, in exchange for the prime lakefront property near the mouths of Lower Anderson Cove and Haw Branch.

The agency no longer needs the 23 acres -- some of which TVA retained as part of a safety harbor to shelter recreational and commercial navigators in distress -- because the designated harbor was moved to the

Critics make waves Over TVA's proposed Pickwick land swap

COUNCE, Tenn. — Casting a curious glance at passing boaters, a deer wanders onto a limestone outcropping at water's edge along a wooded cove of Pickwick Reservoir known as Haw Branch.

At almost any other spot on the booming north shore of Pickwick, the animal couldn't have reached the lake without idestepping freshly turned dirt, new foundations and pillars supporting half-million-dollar vacation and retirement homes under construction.

But in Haw Branch, towering pines, sycamores and white oaks still envelop rustling reeks. Boaters entering the cove hear only the calls of birds and see only the veil of vegetation on rugged hillsides.

Under a proposed property exchange with a major developer, this area soon could belong to the Tennessee Valley Authority, which plans to preserve it for hiking and similar kinds of public recreation.

But to many area residents and lake-users, the cost of the deal appears as steep as the land itself. More than 200 of them recently signed petitions opposing the exchange between TVA and Montana Land Co., which is based in Savannah, Tenn., charging it would cause environmental damage and cheat ratepayers.

The deal, proposed by the company, would bring the federal utility 164 acres that Montana Land owns along the upper end of Haw Branch. In exchange, TVA would give up 23 acres of prime lakefront

land near the mouths of Lower Anderson Cove and Haw Branch. (A1, A2)

TVA is reviewing public comments and wrapping up an environmental assessment of the proposal. The matter eventually will go before the federal utility's three-member board with a final decision expected later this year.

While the deal would give Montana Land prime acreage for more high-dollar home sites, TVA officials contend the public would benefit as well.

With the exchange, some of the fast-dwindling undeveloped land on the lake will be preserved for recreation, agency officials say.




"One of our interests is to protect natural resources and provide the public the opportunity to use those resources in an undeveloped setting," said TVA spokesman Tim Meeks.

"As development goes on, it's securing a place that would be suitable for public involvement."

Barbara:

I have attached a copy of the report on Haw Branch below. This report does not have the list of aquatic insects collected as I did not have that saved electronically. I can fax you this, however, if you want it. Bottom line is, it scored the highest possible score for the biological component and a 176 out of 200 possible points on the habitat assessment. Haw Branch (east fork only) is now our 1st order 65J ecoregion reference stream based on this recent assessment. This means that this stream will be used to compare all other 1st order 65J streams to when determining their ability to support fish and aquatic life. Haw Branch (east fork only) is also classified as exceptional waters because of its high biological score.

This assessment of Haw Branch does not extend downstream of the confluence of Haw Branch with its embayment. Our Division currently does not have a biological scoring system established for reservoirs/embayments.

Hope this information is helpful to you.

Re: Preserve full service marina

On Thursday, 22 February 2007, we (friends of Pickwick) had our on site visit. It was apparent how narrow the Haw Branch cove was. The boat ramp was under construction. The ramp was not to have been started and yet was well underway before the time period had expired. What will the Corp do about this? It would appear the ramp is partly on public land.

The marina plans A dock and B dock has them a 165' across when it really is 120'. The back of Haw Branch is not that wide (165') in the back, C dock plans has it at 140' wide where calls for it to be 108' when in fact the cove is less than 100'.

When we were in the back of the cove close to the boat ramp in question, it was obvious how narrow the back was. The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) has inspected the cove and stated in a letter that their plans would not meet the 1/3 1/3 1/3 requirement without extensive dredging.

The boat docks would extend into the water 42'. The slips are 24'. The average boat is approximately 40' which would add another 16' to the 42' and would extend out into the water 58'.

The Corp plans to let this big full service marina operate under a 26a permit. This is unheard of. Then is the Corp going to approve dredging when asked for?

It would be unconscionable to destroy this beautiful cove with the Wildlife, Eagles, Heron and wet lands and Exceptional Water with Tier=2 rating of 176 out of 200.

I have owned property on Pickwick Lake since 1960. Anyone wanting a boat dock would be required to get a 26a permit. Some of the applicants have been disapproved. Now a full service marina under a 26a permit has been given the green light.

If the Preserve management would alter their plans to Bluff Creek, I'm sure they would be approved.





5 March 2007 (With current public comment period scheduled to end in two days, 3.7.2007)

This (began as) a letter version of the original e-mail with formal requests (see page two) sent on 2.26.07 to TVA: Tom Kilgore, Susan Tidwell, Stanford Davis, J. Kenley Austin, and to COE: Ron Gatlin, Amy M. Robinson, Bradley Bishop.

Re: **SERIOUS ISSUES, URGENT FORMAL REQUESTS:** Following 2.22 joint site visit (that we'd been requesting for over 5 weeks), with TVA & COE officials.

FYI: Meeting to review specs/on site for controversial "pre-approved" 200 ft boat ramp permit and proposed "Preserve MARINA Owners Assn Inc" project for boat facilities (that developers' brochures and current website all describe as a "Full Service Marina & Storage" (vs. "community docks"), but both with adverse impact.

Note: While 2 extensions (21 days) have been granted by officials, this is effort by users of an responders to initial requests, requests to meet information withheld (WHI), continuing provisions, reduce serious issues (details as follows)



AT ISSUE IS...a quarter of a mile+ of boat docks, 50-60 boat slips, headers, 160ft. watercraft pier, gangways, etc...proposed along natural shorelines in narrow back of pristine Haw Branch cove, Pickwick (Public Notice 07-01)...plus, 200 ft boat ramp that was pre-emptively "pre-approved" via a highly questionable TVA 26a permit (approved 2 days after \$200 fee was paid 12.18.06) and other discrepancies. Plus, due to indisputable substantial environmental controversy surrounding this project, the "Categorical Exclusion" given the boat ramp disregarded specific limitations outlined in NEPA Environmental Review regulations. As a result, the boat ramp, will/was not subject to the same environmental & regulatory reviews as all the boat docks, slips, etc for same project, by the same applicant, at same site, violating federal regulations barring 'piece-mealing' reviews or approvals, as referenced by Corps of Engineers official during 1.16.07 phone call, our first opportunity to discuss this Public Notice with officials following issuance by TVA / COE 1.12.07. Also at issue are specs (narrow cove vs. dock sizes), ramp location, adverse impact on water quality, aquatic habitat, natural shorelines, adjoining public land, adjacent "Exceptional Tier II waters" recreational and safety issues, as well. See TWRA letter, raising like concerns, challenging valid "one third of cove" compliance, requesting action be "held in abeyance", pending resolutions.

OUR PURPOSE IS CONSERVATION & COMPLIANCE...urging officials to enforce regulations and honor policies (as NEPA requires): "to make better decisions based on an understanding of environmental consequences, taking actions that protect, restore, enhance the human environment." Please consider the attached list of violations and actions, seemingly not in compliance with regulations, decision documents, and in stark contrast with commendable environmental policies.

We also urge local and Destin developers to seriously consider ample empirical/fiscal evidence of "overwhelming positive economic effect on property values" (up 20-33%) when passive and natural areas in proximity are preserved...not to mention the obvious PR and marketing value if "The Preserve at Pickwick" owners opted to live up to it's admirable namesake and 'Preserve' the last pristine cove as a *signature feature*, in this densely developed area of Pickwick lake. Afterall, within this 1200 acre project, there are miles of other shorelines available, better locations outside of Haw Branch, for these proposed boat facilities (and/or current published plans for a "Full Service Marina & Storage"?) We urge developers to *preserve, not destroy*, this last pristine cove for future generations of wildlife, area residents (including those in 'The Preserve') and countless visitors attracted to Hardin County for the recreational and natural scenic beauty more at risk now than ever, amidst the rampant development in this and other areas of Pickwick.

Furthermore, Friends of Pickwick goes on record again, refuting false claims by local officials and interested parties, that we oppose the project itself, or promised economic benefits to the area. We cannot and do not oppose 'The Preserve' in any way. Our sole goal is to try and save a small part of the last pristine cove in the area, just the narrow back of Haw Branch cove, behind the public lands we saved from a TVA/Montana Land Co land swap in 2000...same area TVA officials once described as "pristine, critical habitat, adjacent to protected wetlands and public lands... and *virtually undevelopable*" due to narrow width, natural areas and environmental restrictions.

FORMAL REQUESTS: We realize it's highly unlikely this developer will forsake potential profits for the more intangible 'win-win' in choosing to "Preserve" God's work in this pristine cove, but we also recognize his private property and access rights...as long as the project complies with all TVA/COE regs. But, at the same time, citizens have a right to expect that these regulations will be enforced, that formal environmental policies will be honored, on the ground...and, that public interest and involvement will be encouraged, not discouraged or discounted - even if it may conflict with in-house pre-conceived conclusions or other underlying issues. While we admire many of the individual agency pros we've met, there seems to be a culture in certain circles that resists inquiries or verifications, understandably perhaps. But, as a result, citizen groups seeking to grasp and participate in this complex process, may find it hard getting timely answers/actions, to valid questions, without repeated requests and help from the outside or higher-ups, especially under the pressure of short public comment deadlines, in a big, busy bureaucracy. For example, we've been denied very important pertinent public information (thru proper TVA channels, then FOIA) for over 7 months now...and it took us over 5 weeks just to get that on site meeting. Other response delays were explained by one TVA exec who warned - if you choose to direct questions to a higher level, (when other efforts fail), then you have to allow time for questions to "roll down, then roll back up" before you get answers. But, when a conservation group like ours is "under the gun" of looming comment deadline, what do we do? Seriously? We submitted these requests 2.26.07 and while officials responded with 7 day extension to 3/7, that was almost a week ago and still no answers. Yet, FINAL comment deadline is 2 days away again. Is this fair and meaningful public participation?

1. We formally requested (2/26) that flawed original Public Notice be withdrawn, pending review of all irregularities, then resubmitted properly as "one Notice for all proposed work", (as recent Corps email stated was "expected"), free of all discrepancies and full access to all requested information.
2. We formally requested (2/26) work stop on boat ramp that we'd first contested 1.16.07, due to regulatory violations prohibiting 'categorical exclusions' for controversial projects, bans on piecemeal approval process (according to COE official), and potential impact on public lands. Why did Corps officials appear to be re-examining issues, say original Public Notice "expected to be withdrawn", but then abruptly revert to terms of original Public Notice? Amidst this time-consuming confusion, we also asked TVA officials to make sure work did not proceed on the boat ramp pending resolution of those outstanding issues, but when we pulled into cove during site visit 2.22, we were shocked to see boat ramp already being built. Mr. Austin said he didn't know work already had begun. Was this "ask forgiveness later"? Officials later admit to "appearance" issues on ramp.
3. We also formally requested TVA revoke the boat ramp permit (per regs), since "the structure was not in accordance to approved plans". We discovered later, boat ramp was NOT being constructed at same location shown on approved plans (TVA 12.20.06). This is a clear 26a permit violation!
4. We formally requested confirmation of exact location of boat ramp...on public or private land? New location either adjoins or encroaches on public lands, contrary to location approved on 26a permit plans. TVA's Stan Davis agreed that topo map was not definitive proof either way. A cease and desist should be issued pending resolution of all these serious issues and permit violations.
5. Since 26a regs and CE's both bar any project with potential adverse impact on public land from qualifying for an "Exclusion" or 26a permit, why were these regs ignored, even tho there will be unmistakable adverse environmental impact on adjoining public lands? Also, on CEC boat ramp Environmental Checklist, why are most review notes dated 5 weeks after the permit was approved?

On behalf of hundreds of residential and recreational 'Friends of Pickwick' and future generations of wildlife, we urge TVA/COE officials to honor these requests and answer questions (submitted 2.26.07) and important NEPA clarifications (submitted 3.1.07). Please respond. Thank you.
