TVA Kingston Ash Recovery Project River System Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis Public Comment Period

A public comment period will take place Aug. 11 – Sept. 10, 2012, for the Kingston Ash Recovery Project's River System Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA).

The Tennessee Valley Authority is working with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) to restore the Kingston ash spill.

As part of that process, a River System EE/CA has been prepared by TVA and approved by the EPA, in conjunction with TDEC. The EE/CA describes the alternatives developed for restoration of the river system.
