Archaeological Monitoring and Protection and ARPA



Key Facts

- ◆ Preserves property and resources
- ◆ Deters looting
- ◆ Protection of site information
- ◆ Training of officers

| Security checks per year | ◆ By reported incident | ◆ 5,000 site visits |
| Codified Regulations | ◆ N/A | ◆ Establish prohibiting the removal of artifacts or historic items |
